Please reach out to our call center at 732-413-2030 to find out if you or members of your family, who are health center patients, are eligible to a telemedicine visit. The call center is staffed with trilingual personnel who speak English, Spanish and Portuguese, Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
